### **Department Meeting:**

Assistant Chief Cole opened the department meeting.

The meeting was called to order by Assistant Chief Jason Cole. Asst Chief Cole noted that Chief Samantha Cole had to work tonight and apologized for not being able to attend. Lieutenant Elliott is doing ride time for her intermediate class.

Chaplain German was not present to give a financial report. Assistant Chief Cole added that about \$6,500 worth of donations have been obtained from residents in the past three weeks. The monitor payment is about \$8,000, so we are doing very well with donations again this year.

Assistant Chief Cole announced that effective Thursday, Captain Stu Morrison has been promoted to Deputy Chief of Operations and will assume the call sign of M4. Captain Natasha Kinney will now have the call sign of M5. Deputy Chief Wagner will retain the call sign of M3 and be the Deputy Chief of Administration. The other officer positions will be filled soon, with the current officers continuing to serve in the positions until decisions are made.

Chief Cole, Assistant Chief Cole, Lieutenant Elliott and Driver Engineer Elliott just got back from the 3 days chief conference. There were a lot of great items on safety that we are looking into.

The ambulance committee has decided to go with Horton for the new ambulance. The final spec's and build pictures are being done. This was a hard decision as we saw a lot of great ambulances and really great dealers. We would like to thank all the vendors who came down with excellent products and took the time to meet with us.

We are looking into gear for highway safety gear - we looked at some while at the Chiefs Conference.

There has been a lot of calls this year and everyone is thanked for helping out to ensure we have crews.

Stipend checks should be out within the first couple weeks of July.

There are a lot of sporting details coming up - for almost every night over the next 2 weeks there are baseball all-star games starting at 5:30pm. There is also a womens softball league that their season is starting up and they would like us to attend.
